

Paying Medical Expenses

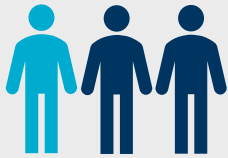
64.2% 

of Minnesotans had a medical bill of **\$200 or more** in their household in the last year.

More Common in Households That  Are Younger  Have Private Coverage and/or  Higher Incomes

7 in 10
of those who experienced such expense found it to be **a problem to pay**.

Cost & Insurance Barriers



1 in 3 Minnesotans consider the **cost** of a visit a **problem** when receiving care.

This percent **decreases** for Minnesotans 65+ and those with other public coverage.



Minnesotans with private coverage consider **worries about insurance coverage** a problem.



Issues With Prescriptions Due to Cost



69.6% of Minnesotans took a **prescription drug** in the past year.



Of those, 1 in 6 had a **cost-related issue** with their prescription.

Drug costs issues are **lower for adults 65+**, likely due to Medicare coverage.
