Minnesota Health Access Survey Insurance Snapshot



While the majority of Minnesotans have health insurance, **many continue to forego care due to costs or experience financial burden in paying medical bills.** Rates of dental insurance are **increasing** but remain low among certain populations.



Over 95% of Minnesotans Have Health Insurance



1 in 4 Minnesotans went without some type of medical care in 2023 **due to costs**



1 in 8 Minnesotans experienced a **financial burden** in paying medical bills

80% of Minnesotans Have Dental Insurance



Hispanic people, low-income people, and people in rural areas are **less likely** to have dental insurance

Pandemic Effects on Health Insurance and Care

Minnesota maintained coverage throughout the pandemic for people who relied on Medical Assistance and MinnesotaCare.

As a result, in 2021:



More Minnesotans received insurance from **government-run programs**, such as Medicaid.



Fewer Minnesotans received insurance from **private programs**, such as those that individuals or employers pay for.



Fewer Minnesotans were **uninsured**, though this change is small and could be due to random variation over time.
